





A fter a long year spent under COVID restrictions, we were thrilled to host a very different type of annual fundraiser. Instead of the usual Casino Night or fancy Gala, we decided it was time to plan something that our CASA children could enjoy as well. What started as a fundraiser raised over \$100,000 and became so much more!

Over 370 CASA supporters, foster children, Board, staff, and volunteers came out for an evening of childhood wonder beneath the stars at Turtle Back Zoo. With the park reserved just for CASA, guests were free to explore unimpeded by lines or crowds. Children rushed about gleefully, donning animal masks given out at the door. Spectators of all ages marveled at the extraordinary sights: majestic giraffes, curious pink flamingoes, lions lounging about regally, cheetahs licking their paws to groom their elegant coats, and a large black

bear lumbering about. Several peacocks roamed the sidewalks freely, taking guests by surprise when they opened their massive plumage to display vivid royal blue and iridescent greens.

Throughout the evening, more important than any thrilling sights or attractions, we bonded as one CASA family. Siblings who are placed in different foster homes ran side-by-side from one attraction to the next. Board members' grandchildren rode the carousel alongside our foster children. Volunteers enjoyed a scenic train ride with their Fostering Futures teens. Adopted families, once on our CASA caseload, attended for a "reunion" with their CASA advocates and Case Supervisors.

In the spirit of family, togetherness, and belonging, we gathered for a delicious buffet-style meal, complete with ice cream and, of course, animal cracker cookie boxes. There was even a birthday cake to celebrate a ten year old's special day. Our talented Board member Regina, who is also a professional photographer, snapped photos as groups gathered to have a keepsake from the event. Best of all, foster children and families were able to leave behind their challenges and enjoy the wonder of nature, friendships, and a fun, safe, enriching experience.

These children and families left inspired to understand, appreciate, and protect the fragile interdependence of all living things, the joy of having spent time with family, and the knowledge that CASA is there for them. CASA added a new adventure to their story. At the end of this magical evening, there were many sleepy children, lots of smiles, and numerous guests asking when CASA would be doing this again.



OUR MISSION

Our mission is to be a strong voice for the best interests of vulnerable children who have been removed from their homes or are under court supervision due to abuse, neglect, or abandonment. We recruit, train, and supervise community volunteers to be advocates, mentors, and champions for each child on his or her journey to a safe, permanent, and nurturing home.



Siblings Zaniyah, age seven, and Zyel, age two, were removed from their parents and placed in the care of their maternal grandmother by the Division of Child Protection and Permanency (DCPP). Their mother, Dawn, had been arrested for selling cocaine, while the children were left home alone. Their father was incarcerated on criminal charges and serving a long sentence.

Susan, a CASA volunteer, was assigned to advocate for the two children, but she ended up helping the whole family. She learned that Zaniyah had severe behavioral issues, and observed possible developmental delays in Zyel. Further inquiry revealed that while Zaniyah was seeing a child psychologist, Zyel's issues were not being addressed. Susan immediately contacted the Case Worker to recommend an Early Intervention Evaluation. As a result of Susan's

diligence, Zyel received a diagnosis of Sensory Perception Disorder. Because of her CASA Advocate training, Susan knew that early intervention services were publicly funded. She was able to connect grandma with the appropriate services that included physical, occupational, and speech-language therapies for Zyel.

Attending all Treatment meetings, Susan sought to learn as much as possible about Sensory Perception Disorder. Zyel's Occupational Therapist informed her that a compression shirt would be helpful in improving his body orientation. Knowing grandma had limited income, Susan first approached DCPP to pay for this shirt. They denied the request and it was not covered by Medicaid. With Zyel's best interest in mind, Susan searched online and found an affordable option that CASA purchased for him.

While the children were set on a positive path, Susan saw through her visits at the home that raising two young children with special needs was a serious challenge for grandma. Susan arranged several extracurricular activities to provide stimulation for the children and free time for grandma. A local library for a Polar Bear Express party, a Home Depot children's craft day, and various local community playground outings, allowed grandma to sit back and watch while Zaniyah and Zyel enjoyed experiences with other children.



It was through the CASA volunteer's diligent efforts and effective advocacy in looking out for the best interests of the two children that resulted in a family's reunification.



ooking to provide further relief,
Susan looked into The Little Gym
for Zyel and soccer lessons for Zaniyah.
Susan put in a recommendation that
DCPP fund these services. When this
was only partially funded, CASA helped
cover the balance. Both children were
delighted with their new activities.

While Zaniyah and Zyel were making progress living with grandma, mom was complying with court orders to attend outpatient drug rehabilitation and parenting classes. From the beginning, Susan developed a positive relationship with Dawn, letting her know that her children loved her and they were rooting for her. As she progressed through her treatment, things were looking positive for Dawn to be reunified with her children, until she began a relationship with a new boyfriend who turned out to be very controlling.

He stole money from her and did not allow her to have weekly visits with her children. Susan also noticed bruises on Dawn's face.

Susan again got to work, providing Dawn with the contact for a Domestic Violence shelter. Over the next several months, they met weekly to plan for future reunification. To help Dawn restore control of her finances, Susan helped Dawn open a checking account and showed her how to create a budget. With Susan's support and encouragement, Dawn began attending Narcotics Anonymous meetings, and found a sponsor.

Dawn even re-established a relationship with her mother. Susan was the one who convinced mother and daughter to enter counseling together for the best interest of the children. After a long, difficult journey, this family is moving towards a positive outcome. They lived in domestic violence subsidized housing for nine months until they were able to afford their own apartment. The children spent weekends at their grandmother's house, allowing Dawn to take on extra hours at her job as a taxi dispatcher.

Because of a dedicated CASA volunteer, a mom and her two children found their way to a better life. A CASA volunteer helped


